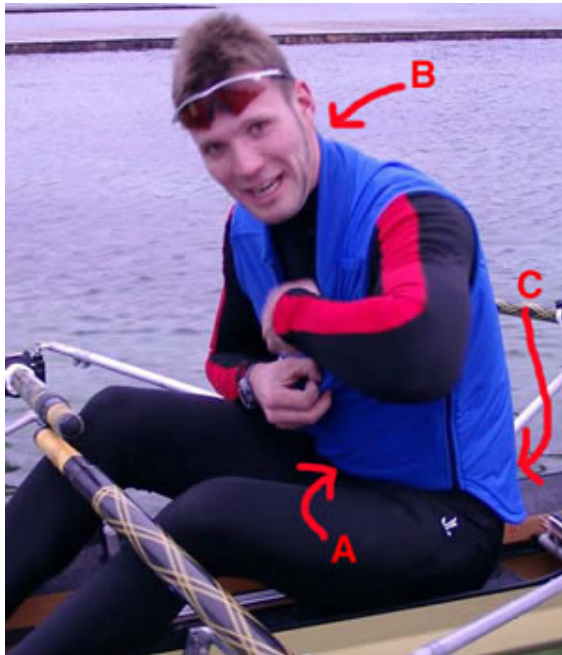
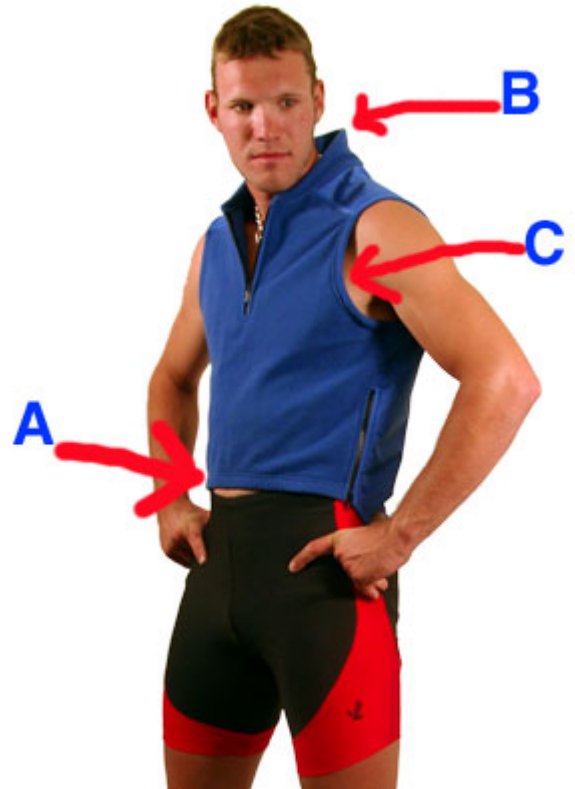


How The JL Turtleshell Should Fit

- A. When standing upright, the Turtle will appear short in front. **This is correct.** The turtle is designed to enable complete manoeuvrability when sat in the boat without excess material getting in the way. Resist the temptation to pull it down or to get a bigger size if your belly shows. See image below...
- B. High collar in the back, low V-neck in the front keeps the back of your neck warm but won't interfere with the motion of your chin. Again, see bottom image for in-the-boat collar shape.
- C. Armholes are cut so that when at your full reach, you won't be chafed in front. Most people would wear a technical shirt of some kind under the Turtle anyway, but the design prevents any rubbing.



- A. Notice that the front is now the perfect length when sat in the boat.
- B. The high collar in back will now keep the neck protected.
- C. The long tail of the Turtle lays flat against the lower back, keeping the lumbar region warm and dry. See that the tail will not catch in the tracks, as it is designed to float above.
